Uniform and Appearance Policy

Students are expected to wear smart business attire, and be neat and tidy at all times.

Reference guidelines can be found in the table below:

| Item | Expectation |
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| Trousers | No jeans, sweatpants, exercise pants, cargo shorts, short shorts (six inches above the top of the kneecap), sports shorts, leggings (Leggings are allowed only when worn under a dress code approved clothing item (Shorts, skirts and dresses), spandex or other form-fitting pants such as gym pants. |
| Skirts | No short or tight skirts and dresses No mini-skirts, hot pants, skorts, sun dresses, beach dresses, and spaghetti-strap dresses. |
| Shirts | No Tank tops, Hoodies, midriff tops or clothing representing drugs, tobacco, alcohol, sex, gang's violence or are crude, suggestive or divisive in words or pictures. T-shirts must be worn under another blouse, shirt, jacket, or dress and not visible. Shirts/tops must cover the midriff, waist, back and cleavage and must not be excessively tight fitting or see through. |
| Shoes | No Branded Sports Shoes, Trainers, Skate Shoes, flip-flops, slippers. |
| Jumpers | No hoodies – unless it is a CIS hoody |

Sportswear, hooded tops, hats and caps are not business attire and should not be brought into school.

The school has the right to send students, who do not attend in full uniform, home, to change into the correct attire.
